Gopeng Subsidiary raises RM180mil from first tranche of green sukuk programme

Gopeng Bhd's wholly owned subsidiary GBS Green Sdn Bhd has raised RM180 million from the first tranche of its ASEAN Green Sustainable and Responsible Investment (SRI) Sukuk Wakalah programme.

In a filing with Bursa Malaysia today, Gopeng said the sukuk forms part of a larger Islamic medium-term notes programme of up to RM500 million in nominal value, established on March 6, 2026.

"The issuer successfully completed the first issuance of Tranche 1 ASEAN Green SRI Sukuk Wakalah amounting to an aggregate of RM180 million in nominal value," it said.

Gopeng said proceeds from the sukuk will be utilised for shariah-compliant purposes, including financing and refinancing eligible green projects, as well as covering construction and development costs and meeting reserve requirements.

It said the proceeds will also be used to defray programme-related fees, expenses and financing costs, as well as to support working capital needs. – The Star

PetGas' Pengerang LNG unit issues RM800 mil sukuk

PETRONAS Gas Bhd's (KL:PETGAS) subsidiary Pengerang LNG (Two) Sdn Bhd has issued RM800 million in Islamic medium-term notes under a RM3 billion sukuk programme.

The company in a filing with the bourse said the issuance, completed on March 30, 2026, was undertaken via a sukuk murabahah programme based on the shariah principle of murabahah through a tawarruq arrangement.

The RM800 million sukuk was issued in 11 tranches with tenures ranging from five to 15 years and periodic distribution rates between 3.68% and 4.09% per annum.

CIMB Investment Bank Bhd acted as the sole principal adviser, lead arranger, and lead manager for the sukuk programme and issuance.

Proceeds from the issuance will be used for payments related to a jetty usage agreement, as well as for working capital, capital expenditure, general corporate purposes, and funding a finance service reserve account.

PetGas said the group's gearing is expected to increase slightly, although it will continue to maintain a prudent capital structure. – The Edge Malaysia

10-year Treasury yield falls as traders weigh odds of Iran war ending, future Fed policy moves

The 10-year Treasury yield edged lower on Tuesday as investors assessed the likelihood of the conflict in the Middle East reaching a resolution as well as the outlook for the Federal Reserve's interest rate path.

The yield on the 10-year Treasury fell more than 2 basis points to 4.321%. The 2-year yield dropped more than 2 basis points to 3.801%, while the 30-year Treasury yield was up more than 1 basis point at 4.919%. The U.S.-Iran war continues to hold the attention of investors across the globe, and yields continued to slip after an unconfirmed report that the Iranian president was prepared to end the war with guarantees.

Elevated oil prices are fueling both inflation concerns and recessionary fears, thereby clouding the outlook for monetary policy trajectories.

Money markets are now overwhelmingly pricing in zero rate cuts from the Federal Reserve for the rest of the year, according to the CME's FedWatch tool. Last week, futures traders briefly pushed the probability of a rate increase by the end of 2026 to 52%. – CNBC
