## **Khazanah launches Malaysia's first tokenised sukuk in RM100mil pilot with SC**

Khazanah Nasional Bhd has issued Malaysia's first tokenised sukuk worth RM100mil in collaboration with the Securities Commission Malaysia (SC), marking a pilot initiative to test the use of blockchain technology in the domestic capital market.

In a statement, SC said the issuance forms part of the Sukuk Danum Programme. This is an Islamic Medium-Term Notes (IMTN) programme of up to RM20bil in nominal value, with a one-year tenure for this inaugural tranche, structured based on the Shariah principle of Wakalah bi al-Istithmar.

A tokenised bond (or sukuk) refers to a digital representation of the capital market product. This involves the adoption of Distributed Ledger Technology (DLT) to create the product in digital form, typically as a token. Tokenisation enables the creation of a digital record or "digital twin" of the capital market product that is cryptographically secure and immutable.

The SC added that by merging shariah-compliant assets with DLT, this initiative aims to enhance accessibility, efficiency and transparency within the capital market, allowing 24/7 access to information to relevant stakeholders. – The Star

## **Bank Islam raises RM1bil via latest tranche of RM10bil sukuk issuance**

Bank Islam Malaysia Bhd has issued its 10th tranche of RM1.0 billion sukuk under its RM10.0 billion sukuk Murabahah programme. In a statement, Bank Islam said the issuance will support balance sheet management while diversifying its funding sources.

Proceeds will be utilised for Shariah-compliant purposes, including financing banking activities, working capital requirements and other general corporate needs, it said. Group chief executive officer Raja Datin Paduka Teh Maimunah Raja Abdul Aziz said the strong response reflects continued investor confidence in the bank's fundamentals and credit strength.

"This also underscores our disciplined approach to balance sheet management and our commitment to ensuring sustainable funding to support the bank's growth and the evolving needs of our stakeholders, in line with Shariah principles," added Teh Maimunah.

The sukuk carries tenures of seven and 10 years, with fixed profit rates of 4.01 per cent and 4.10 per cent per annum respectively. The papers are rated AA3 with a stable outlook by RAM Ratings Services Bhd. – New Straits Times

## Treasury yields rise as U.S.-Iran peace talks hit an impasse

U.S. Treasury yields rose on Tuesday as investors awaited developments on negotiations between the U.S. and Iran, which hit an impasse over the weekend. The yield on the 10-year U.S. Treasury note — the key benchmark for U.S. government borrowing — added 1 basis point to 4.346%. The 2-year Treasury note yield, which more closely tracks short-term Federal Reserve interest rate policy, was more than 3 basis points higher at 3.836%.

President Donald Trump and his national security team discussed Iran's proposal to reopen the Strait of Hormuz if the U.S. lifts its blockade and the war ends, White House press secretary Karoline Leavitt confirmed on Monday. The proposal would postpone negotiations on Tehran's nuclear ambitions for a later date, Axios and The Associated Press reported.

It's unclear whether Trump, who has vowed not to lift the blockade until a deal with Iran is "100% complete," entertained the reported offer to end the two-month-old war. Oil prices edged higher Tuesday as uncertainty lingered over the outcome of the war.

Bond investors are also be looking ahead to the Fed's two-day monetary policy meeting that wraps up Wednesday, when outgoing Fed chair Jerome Powell and the Federal Open Market Committee are widely expected to keep interest rates on hold at their current 3.50% to 3.75%. – CNBC
